

## The Scholarship Fund of Trinity Episcopal Church

Each year, the Vestry award scholarships to worthy students in our parish, in part to further the legacy of Mabel Shepard, a longtime Branford educator and the Goodrich Family. We are very proud of our Trinity students, younger and older, and wish them great success in their educational pursuits. As in the past, the monetary amount of the scholarships is dependent on the amount of income earned by the respective Funds in the preceding year.

## History

In 1986, Trinity Church received from the Estate of Mabel Frances Shepard, a longtime Branford educator, the proceeds from the sale of her home, and an additional sum of money, for the creation of a trust fund known as The Shepard Fund, in memory of Mabel Frances Shepard, her grandmother, Mary Frances Shepard, her father, Edward Baldwin Shepard, and her mother, Ellen Sherman Shepard. The Trustees of the fund are the Rector and the Senior and Junior Wardens; and the fund's income is used, in the discretion of the Trustees, for welfare work within the parish and scholarships for needy and deserving Trinity students. The Goodrich Fund now supplements this to form the Trinity Scholarship Fund.

Over the years, the Scholarship Fund has provided scholarships for Trinity students in colleges and universities, community colleges, trade schools and for continuing education. During recent past years, approximately \$13,000/year was distributed for scholarships to our qualified students within the parish.

## **Application Process**

For those students submitting a **new application**, which is attached hereto, we are requiring each applicant to submit an essay of not less than 500 words on what impact Trinity Church has had on their life, in addition to the application form.

For those students submitting a **renewal application**, we are requiring each applicant to submit a written statement, confirming their enrollment status for the following school year, and reporting on how they are doing, what they have learned, and any major changes that happened during the last year.

The application form is available through the church office, and it is also on the parishioner site under Minutes & More/Administration. Applications for Fall Semester 2016 scholarships should be submitted to the church office or by email to <a href="mailto:juniorwarden@trinitybranford.org">juniorwarden@trinitybranford.org</a> by July 21, 2016. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, as well, for those students with non-traditional school schedules.
