Christian Formation includes:

Bible Study: If you are interested in attending a small group bible study please contact the office.

Faith Development: Participate in small group sessions to explore and develop your faith. Group sessions are offered from time to time throughout the year.

Inquirer's Class: Learn about basic Christianity with emphasis on our Episcopal heritage and practices is offered each year. This class serves as preparation for Baptism, Confirmation, or Reception.

Sunday School Teacher: Adults and older teen-agers are needed as story tellers and doorkeepers for Godly Play program. Adults are needed as teachers for 7th and 8th grade church school class, and high school confirmation group. **
